PSALM 25:10 says, "All the paths of the LORD *are* mercy and truth, To such as keep His covenant and His testimonies."

THE FOLLOWING ARE A FEW OF THE SCRIPTURAL TRUTHS CONCERNING THE ALMIGHTY AND HIS RELATIONSHIP WITH ISRAEL AND THE JEWISH PEOPLE.

NUMBERS 23:19 God does not lie.

GENESIS 12:3 God blesses those who bless Israel and He curses those who curse Israel.

GENESIS 17:7-8 God established an everlasting covenant with Israel and the Jewish people for the Promised Land.

JOSHUA 1-24 God brings the Jewish people into the Promised Land.

2 CHRONICLES 6:6 Jerusalem is God's chosen city and Israel are His chosen people. Israel was, is and will always be evidence of God's promise-keeping integrity.

EZEKIEL 36:19 The Jews are dispersed among the Gentiles outside of present-day Israel after the Babylonians conquered the kingdom of Judah in 586 BCE resulting in many Jews being exiled into slavery by Nebuchadnezzar. Cyrus the Great, the Persian conqueror of Babylonia, permitted the Jews to return to their homeland in 538 BCE, however, part of the Jewish community remained behind.

Diaspora Jews outnumbered the Jews in the Promised Land before the destruction of Jerusalem in 70 CE. Subsequently, the chief centers of Judaism moved from country to

country during the diaspora, such as Babylonia, Persia, Spain, France, Germany, Poland, Russia, and the United States. Some in the Jewish community gradually assimilated into the culture of their host countries. While many Jews lived in peace, others became victims of violent anti-Semitism.

JEREMIAH 24:4-7

God's mighty hand begins to gather the exiles back to their promised homeland.

First mentioned in Deuteronomy 30:3-5, after the details of the destruction and exile are described in Deuteronomy 28:63-64; 30:1, the promise is given, *"the Lord thy God will turn thy captivity and have compassion upon thee, and will return and gather thee from all the peoples, whither the Lord thy God hath scattered thee. If any of thine that are dispersed be in the uttermost parts of the heaven, from thence will the Lord thy God gather thee, and... bring thee into the land which thy fathers possessed."*

ISAIAH 66:8

Israel is reborn on May 14, 1948.

PSALM 83:4

Israel's enemies plot to destroy the nation and erase all memory of its history.

The Jewish people have had a constant presence in the Holy Land since they entered in with Joshua and from that time until today, Israel's enemies have maintained an incessant war against the Jews.

After nearly two thousand years of exile and longing, Israel was reborn as a modern, independent nation, and the last seven and half decades have been nothing less than miraculous. Despite all the wars, all the terrorism, and all the sacrifice, the people of Israel are alive and well—and thriving.

It is crucial that Christian Zionists who believe the Word of God recognize this irrefutable truth: Israel is the covenant homeland of the Jewish people as decreed by the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.
